Living Word Family Church Statement of Faith

1. The Old and New Testaments are the Inspired, Infallible and Authoritative Word of God.

- The Word is the complete revelation of God's eternal and unchanging will for men of all ages.
- The Word is the divine and final authority for the Christian life.

(2 Timothy 3:16, 1 Thessalonians 2:13, 2 Peter 1:21)

2. There is One God in Three Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

- God is the infinitely perfect and eternally existent Creator of all things.

(1 Corinthians 12:4-6, 2 Corinthians 13:14, Ephesians 4:4-6, 2 Thessalonians 2:13,14, Luke 3:21 & Matthew 3:16,17)

3. Jesus Christ is the Union of God and Man.

- He is True God and True man, conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary.
- He lived a sinless life and died on the cross as a sacrifice for the sins of all men.
- He arose bodily from the dead, ascended at the right hand of the Father as our high priest and advocate.

(Philemon 2:6-11, John 14:2-8, John 1:14, John 1:1)

4. Man was Created in the Image of God, but Fell into Sin, Which Resulted in His Spiritual Death and Separation from God.

- Only through regeneration (being "born-again") by the Holy Spirit, can salvation and spiritual life be obtained.
- You are born again when you confess that Jesus is Lord in your life and believe God raised Him from the dead. Old things are passed away and all things are new!

(John 3:5, John 3:16, Romans 10:9-10, Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, 2 Corinthians 5:17)

5. Water Baptism and Communion are Ordinances to be Observed in the Church.

- They are not means of salvation. The shed blood of Jesus Christ and His resurrection provide the only grounds for justification and salvation.

(Matthew 28:19, Romans 6:4, Colossians 2:12, 1 Corinthians 11:23)

6. The Holy Spirit Operates in Our Daily Life.

- He indwells, comforts, guides, instructs, and empowers the believer, for godly living and service with the final purpose of glorifying the Lord Jesus Christ in the earth.
- Every believer should be filled with the Holy Spirit, with speaking in tongues as the initial physical evidence.

(Mark 16:17, Acts 2:2, John 16:17, John 15:26)

7. Prayer is a Lifestyle.

- Every born-again, spirit-filled believer should maintain a consistent prayer life by praying regularly with their understanding and in their heavenly language.

(John 14:16, 17, Acts 2:4, 19:1-7, Mark 16:17)

8. Without Faith it is Impossible to Please God.

- Those who have been justified by the Blood of Jesus shall live by faith.
- We are redeemed from the curse of the law—poverty, sickness, oppression, and any other thing that prevents us from fulfilling His plan.
- Our redemption provides salvation, healing and prosperity as well, for our spiritual, soulish and physical man, as we walk in the light of this redemption by faith in God's Word.

(Galatians 5:13, Romans 3:24, 1 Corinthians 1:30, Colossians 1:14, Ephesians 1:14)

9. The Universal Church is Composed of All Those Who are Born Again.

- Jesus Christ is the Lord and head of the Church.
- He has provided leadership for the local church through the ministry gifts, which only He can give.
- Every local church has the right, under Christ, to decide and govern its own affairs.

(Ephesians 2:14-18, Ephesians 1:22, 2 Corinthians 5:17)

10. The Premillennial Second Coming of Jesus Christ is Two-Part in Nature.

- He will come in the air to resurrect the righteous dead and catch away the living saints.
- He will then come to earth to establish His physical Kingdom and begin His thousand-year reign.

(Acts 1:11, 1 Thessalonians 4:16, Hebrews 9:27)

11. There Will Be a Bodily Resurrection of the Dead.

- Believers go to everlasting joy with the Lord and unbelievers to judgment and eternal punishment, apart from God.

(Revelation 20:6)
